Before and After Liturgy Protocols

Phase Two (Orange) of Metropolis of Chicago *Reuniting Our People With Their Parish Homes* Guidelines

Attendance

- Please call the church office at (312) 243-3738 or use the [link](#) in the emailed version of this protocol to let us know that you are interested in attending a Divine Liturgy in person.
- Each week, there will be a drawing to determine who will attend Liturgy that week.
- Once you have attended a Liturgy, your name will not be drawn again until everyone has had an opportunity to attend a Liturgy.

Before Liturgy

- **Two days** before your assigned Liturgy, Mrs. Vicky Crosby will **call** to ask you a short series of **screening questions** (see below). If Vicky is not able to reach you by phone, she will **email** you a survey with the screening questions.
- **If you do not** complete the screening (by phone or email) by **3 pm**, we must assume that you cannot attend. Your spot will then be offered to another parishioner. Therefore, if you arrive at St. Basil for Liturgy but have not completed the screening questions, we cannot allow you to enter because someone else will be attending in your place.
- To ensure that everyone follows the same safety protocols, you must arrive **no later than 15 minutes after the start** of Divine Liturgy. For weekday Liturgies, you must arrive **on time**, as Fr. Dimitri will be opening the door for you on weekdays.
- If you cannot attend (or arrive on-time for) the Liturgy to which you are assigned, Vicky will reassign you to a different date.

Before Liturgy Screening Questions

- You are scheduled to be at Divine Liturgy on (date) at (time) with (named family members). Can you please confirm that you (you all) are coming?
- Please reply “yes” or “no” to whether you have these symptoms:
 - New or worsening cough
 - Sore throat
 - Shortness of breath
 - Temperature above 100 F (37.8 C)
 - Complete loss of taste or smell
- In the last 14 days, have you taken any medicines to reduce fever (such as Tylenol or Ibuprofen)?
- In the last 14 days, have you been in contact with anyone who has or is suspected to have coronavirus (COVID-19)?

After Liturgy

- **If you become ill after attending a Liturgy**, please first contact your physician, and then alert Fr. Dimitri (church office: (312) 243-3738) and/or Dr. Marina Arvanitis (cell: 630-440-6782) as soon as possible.
- We must alert those who attended Liturgy with you that they have been in contact with someone who has (or is suspected to have) COVID-19.
- We will not provide anyone with your name or any other personal information. Please know that we cannot ethically or legally disclose your personal medical information to anyone, including your co-parishioners.
