



Attendance

- Go to St. Basil's [SignUpGenius](#) page or call Mrs. Vicky Crosby at (312) 243-3738 to sign up for the services you wish to attend.

Before Liturgy

- **1-2 days** before Liturgy, Vicky will **call** to ask a short series of **screening questions** (see below).
- **If you do not** complete the screening questions prior to Liturgy, we must assume that you cannot attend.
- To ensure that everyone follows the same safety protocols, you must arrive **no later than 15 minutes after the start** of Divine Liturgy. For early morning Liturgies, you must arrive **on time**, as Fr. Dimitri will be opening the door for you on weekdays.
- If you cannot attend (or arrive on-time for) the Liturgy to which you are assigned, Vicky will reassign you to a different date.

Before Liturgy Screening Questions

- You are scheduled to be at Divine Liturgy on (date) at (time) with (named family members). Can you please confirm that you (you all) are coming?
- Please reply “yes” or “no” to whether you have these symptoms:
 - New or worsening cough
 - Sore throat
 - Shortness of breath
 - Temperature above 100 F (37.8 C)
 - Complete loss of taste or smell
 - Diarrhea
- In the last 14 days, have you taken any medicines to reduce fever (such as Tylenol or Ibuprofen)?
- In the last 14 days, have you been in contact with anyone who has or is suspected to have coronavirus (COVID-19)?
- In the last 14 days, have you travelled outside of Illinois? If you have traveled internationally or to one of the states covered by the Chicago Department of Public Health [Emergency Travel Order](#), you will not be able to attend Divine Liturgy in person until you have completed a mandatory 14-day quarantine

After Liturgy

- **If you become ill after attending a Liturgy**, please first contact your physician, and then alert Fr. Dimitri (church office: (312) 243-3738) and/or Dr. Marina Arvanitis (cell: 630-440-6782) as soon as possible.
- We must alert those who attended Liturgy with you that they have been in contact with someone who has (or is suspected to have) COVID-19.
- We will not provide anyone with your name or any other personal information. Please know that we cannot ethically or legally disclose your personal medical information to anyone, including your co-parishioners.
