



Before Liturgy – please see the Before Liturgy Protocol for full details

- Complete the screening call 2 days prior to your assigned Liturgy – only those who complete their screening will be able to attend Liturgy
 - Arrive **no later** than 15 minutes after the start of Divine Liturgy. (Exception: For weekday Liturgies, you must arrive **on time** as Father will need to open the door for you).

Entering the Church

- **Put your mask over your nose and mouth** before entering the church – **everyone** over 2 years of age must wear a mask or face covering
 - Go to the Polk and Ashland (street-level) entrance and ring the doorbell to be allowed in – **do not** try to enter other doors
 - Upon entering, **check in** with Nick Katsoulis and Vicky Crosby at the welcome table, and **sanitize your hands**
 - Use the southern stairs (or the elevator if needed) to go upstairs

In the Narthex

- If you desire, leave a check or cash in the donation box – no change will be made
 - **Sanitize your hands again** after lighting your candles, using sanitizer in the narthex
 - Bow and cross yourself to venerate icons – **do not kiss or touch**
 - Stay **6 feet away** from those who do not live in your household
-

In the Nave

- Make sure your mask is **over your nose and mouth at all times** – wearing a mask under your nose or on your chin is not helpful and puts you and your fellow parishioners at risk
 - Bow and cross yourself to venerate icons and relics – **do not kiss or touch**
 - Go to one of the open pews – **do not** remove any tape to sit in taped-off areas
 - Only sit directly next to those who live in your household

Receiving Holy Communion

- If you wish to receive Holy Communion, **follow the direction of the ushers** to exit one pew at a time, starting with the front pew
 - Use the side aisles to proceed to the back of the church, then come up the center aisle to receive Communion
 - Stay **6 feet away** from others while in line by following the markings on the floor
 - **Do not remove your mask until you are directly in front of Fr. Dimitri**
 - Proceed directly to the hand sanitation station (one on each side of the church) to **sanitize your hands and replace your mask** before returning to your pew

Exiting the Church

- Exit one pew at a time, starting with the front pew
 - Use the side aisles to proceed to front of the church to receive antidoron from Fr. Dimitri – **do not kiss Father's hand**
 - **Do not remove your mask to eat your antidoron until you are outside the church**
 - Exit out the front door – **do not congregate in the narthex**
 - If you wish to visit with fellow parishioners, do so outside on the sidewalk while maintaining distance

Other Spaces

- The fellowship hall is for Sunday School classes only – **do not enter or exit through the hall**
