Latest St. Basil Covid-19 Guidelines (May 26, 2021)

In keeping with the updated [Metropolis Guidelines](#), along with current State and City requirements, St. Basil is adopting the following protocols for our Parishioners.

Liturgical Guidelines

- Parishioners will enter through main doors of the Church beginning June 13 (Parishioners will continue to enter from the ADA door until June 13)
- While you will not be asked about your vaccination status, we do require all parishioners to sign in for contact tracing.

- If you are vaccinated, you are no longer required to wear a mask or socially distance. We ask that you sit on the **North side of the Church**

- If you are unvaccinated, we ask you to continue to wear a mask and practice social distancing. For those who are not vaccinated and for those who wish to continue observing social distance, we ask that you sit on the **South side of the Church**.



- Beginning June 6th, coffee hour will resume. Similar to the nave of the Church, the Hall will be split in half to accommodate those who are vaccinated and those who are not. The North side of the Hall will be for those who are vaccinated and the South side of the Hall will be for those who are not or those wishing to continue social distancing. Coffee hour items will be individually wrapped and coffee will be served with a lid
- When the St. Basil Choir resumes in the fall, please be aware that in order to sing in the choir, you must be vaccinated.
